The impressive Bell & Ross BR Instrument Minuteur Tourbillon features a screw-down crown assuring water resistance to 100 meters. The exceptional movement is manually wound with a three-day power reserve gold-anodized aluminum. So, what does all this have to do with the legal profession? We don't know. The watch was previewed at this year's Basel watch fair and exact details haven't been revealed yet. All we know is that this highly complicated movement is presented in a landmark case crafted from satin-finished 18K pink gold fitted with sapphire crystals on both front and back.
